TEEN Driving Statistics

- ✓ Car crashes are the single leading cause of death in teens in the U.S.
 - ✓ Teen drivers with AD/HD are:
 - 4 times more likely to be involved in a crash
 - 4 times more likely to be at fault for accidents
 - 3 times more likely to be cited for speeding
 - 6-8 times more likely to have their license suspended
 - ✓ Teens are 4 times more likely to die in a car crash than adults.
 - ✓ Teen drivers with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) have difficulty with:
 - Executive functioning skills, i.e. attention, shifting, flexibility, planning, processing speed, decision making, etc.
 - Motor coordination
- Safe driving requires ALL of the above to work optimally and in unision.

Driving is a COMPLEX task that requires the following skills to safely engage in the occupation of driving:

- Eye - hand coordination
- Visual scanning and visuospatial skills
- Ability to multi-task
- Planning, organization and problem solving
- Judgement of speed and perceived distances while moving
- Motor skills to effectively steer, accelerate, brake, shift gears and use the controls in a smooth and sequential matter
- Impulse Control
- Flexible thinking to change and unexpected occurrences
- Focus and attention when presented with a variety of distractions
- Ability to anticipate actions of other drivers



- Drivers who talk or text are 23 times more likely to be involved in a crash
- Distracted driving accounts for 9 deaths everyday
- More than 75% of teens admit to texting while driving
